To help you have the most enjoyable time at Lakefront Music Fest, we've put together some helpful information and tips below.

- GETTING TO LAKEFRONT MUSIC FEST: There is no onsite parking at Lakefront Music Fest. <u>CLICK HERE</u> for detailed shuttle information including locations and other important information on getting to the event. View map of park <u>HERE</u>. A limited number of parking spaces are available to reserve for \$20-\$25. Located at Holy Trinity United Methodist Church (16150 Arcadia Avenue). <u>CLICK HERE</u> to reserve and for more information.
- 2. **IMPORTANT UPDATE THIS YEAR:** There is a new parking location at Mystic Lake Casino Hotel. Parking will now be at Hotel Lower Lot. Look for signs.
- 3. **LAKEFRONT MUSIC FEST IS COMPLETELY CASHLESS.** Please come prepared with a debit or credit card.
- 4. WHAT CAN I BRING INSIDE: Please see bag policy below.
- 5. WHERE IS MY TICKET: Please CLICK HERE to search for your ticket.
 - IMPORTANT: Tickets will NOT be available for sale at the gate! Please help us spread the word.
- 6. WHAT CAN I BUY WHEN I AM THERE: In addition to a variety of food and drink options, there is a merchandise tent for unique Lakefront Music Fest t-shirts, sweatshirts and hats!

- 7. WHEN DOES THE MUSIC START: Full line up with approximate on-stage times below.
- 8. **PLEASE DRINK RESPONSIBLY:** Overly intoxicated individuals will not be allowed admission.

BAG POLICY:

As Prior Lake Rotary's Lakefront Music Fest continuously develops security measures to deliver the safest event possible, the following bag policy will be implemented. It is intended this policy will also improve entry process into park.

- Up to one clear bag per person not exceeding 12" x 6" x 12" -OR- one small clutch bag -OR-purse (with or without a handle or strap) no larger than 4.5" x 6.5."
- Diaper bag, must be accompanied with a proper-aged child
- Medical-necessary equipment bags after proper inspection at the gates. The only items allowed in such bags are medical-necessary items.

Bags found to be in violation of this policy will not be allowed into the event area and event producer will not accept responsibility or liability for any bags or prohibited items not allowed in the event area.

ALLOWED IN CONCERT AREA

- Chairs and blankets are allowed, but it is recommended to bring chairs that fold up easily and are easy to get on and off shuttle buses. Chairs are required to come bag free. **No chair bags allowed.**
